

Emergency Housing Vouchers (EHVs)



EHVs help individuals and families find housing and remain stably housed long-term.

Our agency has partnered with Alabama Rural Coalition for the Homeless (ARCH) to determine which individuals and families will be eligible to receive an EHV.






Eligibility Categories:

To be eligible for an EHV, an individual or family must meet one of the eligibility categories:

- Lacks a fixed, regular, and adequate nighttime residence.
- Has an income below 30 percent of median family income for the area as determined by HUD.
- Reasonably believes that there is a threat of imminent harm in their current residence.

To apply, contact ARCH by calling 334-273-0668, and request to apply for an Emergency Housing Voucher Referral.

-  **Homeless or at risk of being homeless.**
-  **Fleeing or attempting to escape domestic violence, dating violence, sexual assault, stalking, or human trafficking.**
-  **Recently homeless.**
